Purpose Areas

1. *A Faithful Response to God's Leading*: We desire to always go before God for guidance and never try to box Him in. A ministry characterized by faith and obedience, even when things don't match our human senses, is an essential part to this ministry.

2. *Non-Denominational Labels*: While maintaining strong theological convictions, we are committed to and embrace the necessity of working with, through, and among other Christians from various denominations.

Blaze

The Blaze initiative is The Grace Institute's local and regional discipleship effort for laity, elder, or pastor training that occurs through learning communities. These studies are meant to help the student integrate deep Biblical truths with everyday life in the Kingdom of God.

The Teleios Initiative is The Grace Institute's Spanish efforts to help provide a way for participants to integrate what is seen in the videos and their study manual with their personal life experiences - all within a transformational learning community. The group is enriched in their understanding of the Kingdom of God and its implications for the environment in which they are located.

The Freedom Initiative is The Grace Institute's effort in East Africa to help pastors and church leaders embrace the true freedom that only comes through a submission to God's word and precepts.



Blaze is an initiative in English that typically uses excellent Biblical and theological materials from partner ministries. Courses we select are then created into the Blaze format. This format includes separating each lesson into short segments. Discussion and application questions are then added to correspond to each of the Blaze lessons. The transcripts and questions are then created into a workbook that can be

either published or used digitally.

Once the workbook is complete, we create corresponding videos using our ministry partner's content. After basic editing, it is then uploaded to Youtube or our digital platform.



TGI Original

Due to need, we created the Basics of the Christian Life course. The course consists of 10 lessons in plain language to reach those Christian leaders who also might be new believers.

Any original course requires writing the script, film, edit, and production of both video and workbook.

App and Platform

An Android and iOS App have been developed in 2020 that will allow students to have the Blaze courses both at home and on the go. The App will also correspond to an online platform. Other features will also be available that will make this App and platform both user friendly and robust. The App and platform should be launched by January 1, 2021.

Distribution

Zoom Groups: Since the beginning of the pandemic in March, we utilized the Zoom platform to offer courses. Since March, three courses have been offered:

The Book of Revelation

The Book of Hebrews

Kingdom, Covenants, and Canon of the Old Testament

In this Zoom format, the group meets for 1.5 hours. They discuss in a large group setting, watch a video, and break into small groups for application. Each student has the opportunity to purchase a workbook to enrich their learning.

To date, 55 different participants have participated in a course.

Production

Teleios is The Grace Institute's initiative for Spanish speakers. Below are the courses we made into the Teleios format. This format includes separating each Thirdmill lesson into shorter segments. This creates more

lessons that then require more questions for discussion and application. This all goes into a workbook that requires professional proofreading, at times editing, and formatting. These workbooks are then sent to publishing or uploaded to a desired digital platform. Once the workbook is complete, we create corresponding videos. This requires video editing of the existing content. After each lesson is complete, it is then uploaded to any desired platform.

Thirdmill Continues to be the bulk of the content that we offer.



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Other Resources

To help our facilitators serve their groups the best that they can, we have created "facilitator guides" that provides stepby-step instructions on how to develop the dynamics of the course, both online and in person.

Along with the facilitator guides, we also have created answer keys to provide the student extra insight as they are completing the lesson's discussion and application questions.

App and Platform

Teleios Distribution

2020 has been both great and difficult for Teleios in the area of distribution. Teleios has been heavily tied into various Bible Societies. For the majority of 2020 it was owned by the Argentine Bible Society. Bible Societies are known for their distribution, but this distribution was in the area of books. When COVID hit, much of that distribution came to a halt. These countries do not have Amazon or FedEx, and so they depend on Promotors from the Bible Societies to deliver to them. Almost immediately, our groups from 2019 ended be-

cause no one could physically meet.

Within a month, we were able to provide our partner Bible Societies a **Teleios platfom** that housed a digital copy of the workbook, the videos, and the discussion questions.

Because physical distribution was and is still suffering in Latin American countries, we have concentrated on building a good LATAM staff, becoming expert consultants, utilizing Zoom, and helping Bible Societies learn how to provide Teleios virtually.

At the beginning of the year, we had thousands of participants. The good was that there were many participants. The bad was that these participants all came from only a few larger groups. When March came around, those students were forced to quit meeting.

By April, we adjusted and our new strategy began. The bad to this was that we were starting with only a small number of participants compared to what we had. The good was that these participants were all leaders of many various ministries and in multiple countries. They began studying via Zoom and being consulted via Zoom to learn how to implement Teleios virtually. This has set us up for large future growth.

Since our updated model, we have reached 556 leaders in 5 countries in Latin America.

Teleios Brand

In late 2020, The Grace Institute acquired ownership of the Teleios brand for everywhere outside of Argentina. Inside Argentina, we are still supporting their effort. For outside Argentina, we are allowed to work beyond the traditional Bible Society. This will help us serve our former contacts in various Latin American countries and also expand to the U.S. ANNUAL REPORT 2020 | The Grace Institute

OC³O FREEDOM

Production

The Freedom initiative is The Grace Institute's effort in East Africa that creatively uses the content of ministry partners to fit the context of the pastors and church leaders that we serve. To produce these courses for our East African students, a different process takes place than Blaze and Teleios. Based on the Blaze course sections, an outline is created that emphasizes Bible verses and main themes. A lot of blank space is left for the student to write out the Scripture and also answer questions about the main themes. Much care is taken in these outlines not to use words that are untranslatable. After the outline is created, they are sent to a translator.

Based on the Blaze sections, videos are recorded. Our Director of Curriculum teaches the lesson in his own words and our Director of African Initiatives translates. Also, based on questions received from the students, informal videos are made to respond and then stored in a database for future use.

All of our content for East Africa is created by Thirdmill. Current courses in 2020.

Freedom Distribution

Freedom Groups: When the lessons are translated, they are sent to different groups throughout Uganda. The students have time to work through them. Then, each Saturday, the groups all "meet" at a certain time via WhatsApp. They are provided the video for the week. They watch the video and then begin sending questions to our Director of African Initiatives. The Director, if he doesn't know the answer or doesn't have a video in the database, asks the Director of Curriculum. This Director, in real-time, records an answer to send back to the students.



As of today there are 10 Freedom Groups participating through WhatsApp. 8 more groups have expressed interest and will begin soon. Also, In February 2021, the Director of African Initiatives will be traveling to Tanzania to speak to over 1,000 pastors who are interested in ongoing study in the Freedom initiative.

Virtual Conferences – In two of the special proj-

ects (Kagavu and Luwero), a virtual conference was provided that mimicked past teaching conferences. The two pastoral group spent months studying the required pre-work. Then, through Zoom, a generator, hotspots, a lot of data, speakers, computer, and projector, we provided over 9 hours of teaching on The Start of God's People. These pastors had never experienced the Internet or communication in this way. During the conferences, the were also provided the normal meal.

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KRS ordination Patrick

This summer, we approached the Kingdom Restoration Society about ordaining Patrick Kibirige, our Director of African Initiatives. Typically, the requirements demand a formal education. After some talks, we agreed on an educational plan for Patrick. Josh Warren, our Director of Curriculum, is mentoring him through this process. After two to three years of education, along with his ministry experience, he will be able to be ordained in the KRS. This is significant because TGI will have a model for an uneducated minister (considering formal education) to have a pathway to a recognized ordination.



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SPECIAL PROJECTS

Special projects hold a special place in the DNA of The Grace Institute. Whereas we have a normal way of distributing Biblical resources throughs various digital platforms, special projects require more creative thought and resources. Typically, those students in our special projects live in a context where the Internet isn't readily available. Sometimes electricity is spotty. Other times, they might be in life situations where they have to study under unusual circumstances. Whatever the case, we want people to engage with God's truth, and so we're committed to these projects.




