Almost There Choreo Plan

- Actors walking across stage Chorus is close together in pods focus is on actors (out)
- "Ain't Got Time for Dancing" actors "dance"/spin, etc.
- "That's just gonna have to wait a while" basses sing to actors (all look at actors) actors look over shoulder at basses
- "Ain't Got Time for Messin' Around" Actors out front exaggerated "messin' around and style" Chorus with similar – but more subdued moves.
- "This old town" arms up to shoulder of guy next to you or arms crossed...
- "But I know exactly" arms down, spread out a bit actors go stage left and make a 2 person pod
- Set on "Almost" focus to director
- "People Down Here Think I'm Crazy" hands up and shake on "Crazy" vocal fall off on "oo" but I don't care– out to audience then back to director on "Trials"
- "Doot doo doo" Out to audience Side step back and forth starting left stop on doot before bass pickup –
 "Daddy" comes forward on last three doo doot doo
- "I remember" focus on Daddy
- "Yes it's true" glance in to each other look in on "It all depends on you" "Daddy returns to chorus"
- "So I work" three parts vocal fall off on work, hard in to director
- Out to audience on "look out world" (stay out for rest of song)
- "Interlude" play air instruments
- "There's Been Trials" to director and actors come forward
- "But I've Climbed and Crossed A River" actors spin
- "Almost" stomp clap
