

This arrangement is intended to be the closing song of a chorus show. It starts with "That's What Friends Are For" and ends with "Keep The Whole World Singing"




(Solo tenor voice - step forward - rest of tenor section join the leads until pick up to measure 10)

(Chorus members move forward - partially off risers)






Bass melody - basses come forward by tenors













(Chorus reduces volume a little as emcee welcomes back guest quartet 1) "Please welcome back our friends "Qtet 1" (Guest quartet sings along)

















Emcee: Now we invite all current and past Barbershoppers and all friends to join us as we close with our theme song!
