

## **About our Summer Camps**

## **Camp Day**

The average day is divided into two morning sessions and two afternoon sessions, with a break in the morning and afternoon, as well as an hour lunch break.

## **Hours & Supervision**

All camps begin at 9:30am and end at 3:30pm. Students WILL NOT be supervised before 9:00am or after 4:00pm and will need to be picked up promptly.

## **Drop Off / Pick Up**

Parents/Guardians should accompany students to the sign in table on the first day of camp. Parents may drop off/pick up their child(ren) at the Parent Pickup area located in the front of the campus for the remainder of the week.

## **Breakfast/Lunch**

A "school-type" breakfast and lunch will be provided. Students can bring their own lunches.

## **Covid Protocol**

The camps will follow the guidelines of The School District of Lee County with students wearing masks and socially distancing.

## **Instruments**

Students must provide their own instruments for Band. Guitars are provided. All String Instruments will be provided! Students should mark all their own instruments with their name.

## **Camp Fee**

Each (in person) camp fee is \$125 per week, which includes all activities, breakfast, lunch and a souvenir t-shirt. No refunds will be issued. An additional \$20 supply fee is required for the Visual Arts Camp & Culinary Arts Camp.
