We recently received a fire risk assessment of our subdivision from the State Department of Forestry and Fire Management (DFFM). Our subdivision received a **Moderate Hazard rating, at the very lowest end of the scale—just one point away from a Low Hazard classification.**

According to DFFM, The Knolls is considered a “best model” of a Firewise Community. This type of assessment goes a long way toward helping us in working with our fire insurance providers, and it reflects positively on all the hard work and care our residents have been putting into preserving this great community.

As you know, each year we must renew our Firewise certification by demonstrating continued steps at “firewising” our homes. Now is a good time to look around your home and property for any fire risks that may exist and to let us know what steps you have taken to reduce those risks by filling out and submitting a Firewise Worksheet (attached).
