Making my way along a hospital corridor to visit some patients, I passed a large window and saw a staff member placing a baby on a scale, recording its weight and measuring its length. I watched as he pressed the tiny feet – one at a time – on an inkpad and created tiny footprint impressions on an official-looking form. Noticing me on the other side of the glass, he nodded at my awed interest and smiled; then continued to record the infant's vital information. I did not want to move away from this sacred moment of witnessing the first few minutes of life of this brand new child of God!

Mary's Child had nobody to document his vital statistics when He was born. However, He did have a host of witnesses who proclaimed His birth to all the world and for all generations.

He was proclaimed by all creation, as represented by the Star of Bethlehem;
by all creatures, represented by the animals in the manger;
by all the poor whom the shepherds symbolize;
by all the rich, by the presence of the Magi;
and by all who make Jesus the center of their lives as witnessed by Mary and Joseph.
