When asked "what was the most meaningful part of Jubilee day?", *Sr. Mavis DeMan* responded: "Jubilee Day was perfect from beginning to end. Even the weather cooperated. It was hot but dry. In preparation for the Liturgy, the choir spent hours practicing, but the time paid off as the music was well done. Dinner took place in our Dining Room. For me to see so many of our Sisters was a great blessing as I come back to Graymoor infrequently because of being stationed in Japan. The opportunity to see and visit with so many Sisters was a blessing." Sister continues to give her all to those she meets daily ~ her gifts are abundantly shared! This Golden Jubilee for 50 dedicated years surely was a blessing for all.
