

SISTERS' WAYSIDE SHRINE WELCOMES YOU TO GRAYMOOR ~ ROUTE 9

Dear Friend:

Located on the very busy commuter NY Route 9, passing travelers and visitors to Graymoor notice the Crucifix Shrine. Beyond it are the Stations of the Cross, a triangle of green space, and the grotto of Our Lady of the Atonement.

Many stop to visit: flowers are offered with a moment of silence; prayers are lifted up; families meet in the green space in sad times or joyful. Long haul truckers in the middle of the night leave their rigs idling as they stop to pray.

A father lights a candle every day on his way to visit his hospitalized child. When his route changes, he leaves \$500 with the request that a Sister continue to light the candle for him each day. A despondent mother leaves the grotto of Our Lady of the Atonement renewed in spirit. A Jewish man tells me he salutes as he drives by, and I assure him that Jesus, a fellow Jew, must enjoy the salutation.


Following the destruction of the crucifix after a severe snow and wind storm on April 1, 1997, one of the first donations for its repair came with the request "Bring Jesus Back." We will never know the full impact of this shrine on those who come to visit, to attend retreats, stop at our Sisters' Gift Shop, or just drive by. Our Sisters pray for all whose lives are touched by this powerful reminder of Jesus' loving presence and action in our lives.
