Holding a one-on-one telephone session with Remedy Max callers will receive a fresh perspective on their situation, an unbiased professional opinion, insights and tools to aid them through their particular life difficulties and personal struggles.

Our BUDDY LINE also helps to serve the needs of individuals who despite having a robust social circle may still feel reluctant to discuss something with their family or friends for whatever reason. By calling the BUDDY LINE to speak with Remedy Max each caller will have the opportunity to openly address a particular situation they are facing and wish to explore or discuss in confidence for positive outcomes.

The BUDDY LINE offers callers a safe space to those needing to just vent, or share their concerns or possibly explore proactive solutions in a non-clinical setting.

RemedyBlox established the BUDDY LINE because we recognized a public social need for a niche target audience whose issues or needs are not associated with services offered by a Psychic Line, Dating Site, Sex Worker Lines or Suicide Prevention Hot Lines.

The BUDDY LINE recognizes the benefit from having open dialogue hence why all callers are offered total call anonymity through this service to facilitate a safe non-judgmental supportive environment including options for resolution on their identified concerns before things spiral out of control.
