### DOCUMENTS NEEDED FOR "MILITARY SERVICE PASS"

1. Paper Application 
2. A valid/not expired proof of identity. These include State ID card/Driver's License, passport, Chicago CityKey, or US Permanent Resident Card (Green Card)
3. A current 2"x2" passport regulation color photo
4. An Official Letter of Disability from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs (USDVA) dated within the last 12 months, that indicates a Service-Connected disability of 10% or greater.
5. \$5.00 Payment can be made with a check or money order; cash is not accepted. Please make payable to Chicago Transit Authority.

### HOW DO I USE MY MILITARY SERVICE PASS TO GET **FREE** TRANSIT?

- Tap your Ventra Military Service Pass to the lower portion of the Ventra reader, which is prominent as you enter the bus and is on top of the turnstile at 'L' stations.
