FOR USE IN SWIMMING POOLS & SPAS

Eliminates yellow or mustard colored debris in pools

Yellow Eliminator is specially formulated to eliminate cloudy water due to accumulations of yellow or mustard-colored debris from pool surfaces.

BENEFITS

- Stain remover Helps remove yellow stains from pool surfaces
- Works as a clarifier Helps clarify and clear cloudy pool water by removing the yellow debris and restores the sparkle to the pool
- No chlorine demand Can be used in pools treated with liquid or dry chlorine products
- Compatible with sanitizers Is compatible with most chlorine based sanitizers used to treat pools

DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOL USE

- Adjust pH of pool water between 7.4 to 7.6, and chlorine residual between 1 to 2 ppm.
- Brush all affected pool surfaces
- Add 4 ounces of Yellow Eliminator per 10,000 gallons to affected areas for maximum effectiveness. For severe accumulation problems, double the dosage of the product.
- Wait 5 minutes and super chlorinate the pool by adding 1 gallon of liquid bleach or 1 pound of dry, granular chlorine per 10,000 gallons of pool water. Follow the chlorine manufacturer's directions for use and method of application.
- For superior water clarity, super shock pool water with a non-chlorine oxygen shock treatment using 1 pound per 10,000 gallons of pool water.

SWIMMING POOL MAINTENANCE DOSAGE

- 4 ounces of Yellow Eliminator per 10,000 gallons weekly when pool water temperature is above 80° F.
- Recommended dosage is 2 ounces per 10,000 gallons, when water temperature is under 80° F.

SPA / HOT TUB START UP

- Yellow Eliminator is concentrated sodium bromide which provides an immediate concentration of bromide salts in the water.
- The addition of most commonly used oxidizing sanitizers and shocking compounds serves to activate this bromide reserve.
- Yellow Eliminator alone, is an inert salt and has no sanitizing or disinfecting properties.
- Always use this product in conjunction with an approved sanitizing and disinfecting product.

SPA / HOT TUB DOSAGE

- Start with chemically balanced water. Check pH, total alkalinity, and sanitizer levels. Circulation and filter system should be operating properly and within manufacturer's guidelines.
- New Fill or Significant Water Replacement: Add 2 oz. of Yellow Eliminator per 500 gallons of spa water.
