



QUESTIONS

- 4. **Can you walk us through your writing process?** How do you go from idea to finished picture book?
- 5. **Your books have such a warm and whimsical tone.** How do you keep your imagination active and your stories so full of heart?
- 6. **The illustrations in Frizzy Lizzy are colorful and full of life.** How did you collaborate with your illustrator to bring Lizzy's world to the page?
- 7. You've said that your life inspired the characters and stories throughout your work. What kinds of things did you learn from these experiences, and how did they influence the story?
- 8. **Kindness, acceptance, and individuality are central to your work.** How do you plan to explore those themes in future books or characters?
- 9. You've mentioned that you regret straightening your hair from what was originally quite frizzy and curly. Looking back now, how has that journey changed your perspective?
- 10. You've created several inventive children's books already. What's next for you—and for Lizzy?
