POLICIES

- *All prospective members must fill out a GMSAR volunteer application prior to attending any training.
 - *All applicants and team members are expected to fully participate in all training activities.
 - *All team members will train to be Team Leaders, and should learn all positions in GMSAR, as they may be called upon to fill that spot during training or a real time search, if only for a short time.
 - *All team members will sign in and out at any event; training or real time search.
 - *Team Leaders is always in charge of the team, and responsible for their safety.
 - *If a team member is lost during a training or real time search, all searches will be ceased until that member is found. Our goal is to find the lost subject, but not at the cost of our own people.
 - *All members must follow our code of ethics, when in contact with other team members, family members and the public.
 - *No alcohol at any time a team member is involved in a GMSAR event.
 - *Smoking is allowed outdoors only in specified areas, and not while searching.
 - *GMSAR ID should be prominently displayed during real time searches.
 - *No photos taken by any member of GMSAR during a real time search, unless cleared by the unit commander.
 - *All members must wear safety green or blaze orange as a member.
 - *Safety glasses are highly recommended if not wearing prescription or sunglasses.
 - *All GMSAR members will be told the truth in what they are looking for, all pertinent information, and known hazards, will be given to them before entering the field.
 - *GMSAR members will not divulge to anybody outside the membership, any information; unless approved by UC.
