Basic Rules: after 'to', use dictionary form of the verb

It is quite easy **to operate** the gadget.

We all chipped in **to help** the fire victim.

Tell the boys **to stop** idling and **help** us clean the hall.



Auxiliary Verb + 'to' + Verb

We **hope to pass** the exam with flying colours.

The herd of cattle **managed to cross** the river.

James **likes to waste** his time on window-shopping.



After adjectives

You are too young **to take** part in politics.

One is never too old **to learn**.



Infinitives without “to”

Let us help the residents **clear** the rubbish.

We saw the traffic police **stop** the lorry.

Don't let any stranger **enter** the house.



Case of 2 infinitives

Mat has been advised **to go** and **apologise** to the teacher.
