

## **ICE Response Policy**

(ICE - Immigration and Customs Enforcement)

I would like to share with you the decision West Grove UMC's Church Council made on the ICE (Immigration and Customs Enforcement) Response Policy on March 19, 2025. Our Bishop Cynthia Moore-Koikoi of Eastern Pennsylvania Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church, encourages local churches to adopt and be prepared with the ICE Response Policy in case ICE or any other Government authority tries to enter WGUMC to search and arrest any illegal immigrants in our church.



We are aware there is a sharp conflict of opinion on the illegal immigrant issues of our nation. So I would like to be transparent with the church's decision on the ICE Response Policy. The main purpose of the ICE Response Policy is not obstructing law enforcement or demonizing our government or increasing political bias within the church, but to uphold our Constitution and protect the constitutional rights of everyone.

We have over 130 Hispanic families receiving food weekly. We don't know how many of them are undocumented people who illegally entered into the U.S. We must protect their constitutional rights, even if they are illegal immigrants. God wants us to have preferred interest toward the poor and needy, widows, orphans, foreigners, the margins of our society. So as long as it is legal, we must protect them from unlawful treatment.

So our basic ICE Response is to not consent to the entry of ICE or any law enforcement without a Valid Judicial Warrant. If they do have a valid Warrant, we will cooperate with them. We are not trying to harbor any illegal immigrants in our church building. But we are trying to be a safe Sanctuary for those vulnerable people as long as we uphold the constitution of our nation.

I pray that West Grove United Methodist Church will find unity and continue to serve together and do the missions of the church and confront the challenges before us.

Joan Leaman and I are designated Point Persons, which are the primary contact and response person, when ICE comes to our church. Feel free to contact us with any questions. The Response Policy is available in the church office as well.


