

* * WEEKLY MEDITATIVE SCRIPTURE * *

Join us each week for the next **52 weeks** in memorizing and meditating on scripture. Each week a different scripture will be featured. It will be listed in the bulletin and put out on Saturday's Constant Contact. Below is this coming weeks scripture and some suggestions on how to study and learn the verse. This weeks verse is Galatians 2:20.

"I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me."

How to Study and Learn This Verse:

- 1. Write out the verse each day. This repetition will help you commit the passage to memory and reflect more deeply on its meaning.
- 2. Set aside time during the week to meditate on the passage or work on memorizing it. Allow the words to shape your thoughts and guide your spirit throughout your daily life.
- 3. Consider what this verse reveals about God and Jesus, as well as themes of salvation, grace, mercy, love and peace.
- 4. REFLECT ON WHAT THE PASSAGE REVEALS ABOUT YOUR LIFE, YOUR RELATION SHIPS WITH OTHERS AND YOUR FAITH IN GOD.
