"TIME: GOD'S CREATION"

As we enter October, the fourth quarter of the year, we are drawn to the divine order of time and seasons. How did they come about? In our Bible study in Genesis, we read, "And God said, "Let there be lights in the vault of the sky to separate the day from the night, and let them serve as signs to mark sacred times, and days and years." (Gen. 1:14)

Time is God's creation. It began when God created the heavens and the earth. God exists outside of time but created time as part of the created universe. He created seasons within time. Psalm 104:19 says, "He made the moon to mark the seasons, and the sun knows when to go down." God created the birds and put time and season within them. Jeremiah 8:7: " Even the stork in the sky knows her appointed seasons, and the dove, the swift and the thrush observe the time of their migration." Time is interwoven within the physical fabric of our lives and reflects change, movement, and the progression of events. God gave us time to govern and control our daily lives. In the creation story, these words of God closed each of the 6 days of creation: "and there was evening, and there was morning," showing that these were 24-hour days of creation. Genesis 8:22, "As long as the earth endures, seedtime and harvest, cold and heat, summer and winter, day and night will never cease."

As we enter this last quarter of the year, what events do we look forward to? We await the fall colors as the trees bring forth the beauty of God's creation. The United Methodist Women have their rummage sale on the first weekend in October. Trunk and Treat comes later in the month. This is followed by All Saints Day, at the beginning of November, when we remember those who have finished their course of life and now spend eternity with our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Later in the month, we celebrate Thanksgiving Day, giving thanks to God for all the blessings we have received.

December marks the beginning of the new church year with Advent, the time when we prepare our hearts for the birth of Jesus. We look forward to the musical celebration of Christmas, directed by Betsy Smith, as this leads us to our Christmas Eve Services and Christmas Day, one of the two greatest days in our Christian faith. The other great day is Easter, the Day of Resurrection.

During this time period, the United Methodist Men will collect toys and clothing for Methodist Services. We trust you will help make this a joyful time for those with little.

Pastor DJ has begun a sermon series on the Lord's Prayer this fall season. Then, he will be on vacation as he returns home to South Korea. In the Advent season, he will bring sermons on, "Can Christmas still change the World?"

As we look forward to this last quarter of the year, we ask for your support of West Grove UMC's mission. Your financial giving helps us serve you spiritually and helps serve our community and the world.





FOOD PANTRY UPDATE

The number of families that visit our church food pantry on a weekly basis, continues to rise. We are averaging about 110 families each week.

This means that more than 450 individuals facing food insecurity in our community are provided nutritious food. While we purchase a small portion of the food we distribute, the major outreach of our church is through the offering of our church facility for the distribution and, most importantly, the volunteers who serve in so many ways.

The Chester County Food Bank relies on food pantries, like the one we provide, to be able to distribute food to vulnerable families throughout the county. Each week we receive, from them, 4 pallets of food that include fresh produce, meat, eggs, cheese and shelf stable food items. Our church is glad to be one of the 39 Chester County Food Bank partner pantries.
