Join us in memorizing and meditating on scripture. Each week a different scripture will be listed in the bulletin as well as Saturday's Constant Contact. Below is this weeks scripture and some suggestions on how to study and learn the verse. **This week's verse is Isaiah 41:10** 

"So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God.

I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand."

#### How to Study and Learn This Verse:

- <u>1.</u> Write out the verse each day. This repetition will help you commit the passage to memory and reflect more deeply on its meaning.
- **2.** Set aside time during the week to meditate on the passage or work on memorizing it. Allow the words to shape your thoughts and guide your spirit throughout your daily life.
- <u>3.</u> Consider what this verse reveals about God and Jesus, as well as themes of salvation, grace, mercy, love and peace.
- 4. REFLECT ON WHAT THE PASSAGE REVEALS ABOUT YOUR LIFE, YOUR RELATION SHIPS WITH OTHERS AND YOUR FAITH IN GOD.
