What are the conditions of being human? To be human is not merely to eat, drink, and sleep, but to be conscious of one's existence and to fulfill one's responsibilities. Human identity is not isolated autonomy, but relational responsibility. We are shaped not just by our own will, but by how we respond to others, to the world, and to God.

For Christians, this responsibility is even greater: we are called by Jesus Christ to be His body by witnessing to the Good News and responding to the eternal needs of the entire human race, while the world demands answers about what to eat, drink and wear, Jesus said:

"A wicked and adulterous generation asks for a sign! But none will be given it except the sign of the prophet Jonah. For as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of a huge fish, so the Son of Man will be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth."

Matthew 12:39-40

What should we do for the world today? What is the church's answer for the cries of our society? Over the next four Sundays, we will journey with the prophet Jonah, who encountered God's Relentless Love while witnessing the Good News to the evil and violent people of Nineveh. I hope and pray that, through this journey, we may find our answer to the broken and hurting world we face today.


