Ethics 360: What Would You Do?

Activity: Small Group Consultations

Time Allotted: 30 Minutes

Process:

- 1. Decide which dilemma(s) to address. (Or use one of your own)
- 2. Assign roles—Licensee Representing the Dilemma, Jotter, Process Leader, Consulting Licensee(s)
- 3. Use the process to come to a recommendation.
- 4. Go to the next dilemma until time is called.

01 Identify the ethical dilemma

Apply the "four-bin" approach. The four bins are: legal, clinical, ethical and risk management.

02 Formulate the ethics question

Given ____(uncertainty or conflict in values/rules), what decisions or actions are ethically justifiable?

OR

Given_____(uncertainty or conflict about values/rules), is it ethically justifiable to _____? (decision or action)?

03 Gather the relevant information

Discuss the facts, context, values conflicts and any relevant information. Who is the client? What is the problem?

04 Identify applicable ethics rules

Site any applicable rule(s). What are the standards?

05 Identify possible courses of action

Identify alternative courses of action or decisions. What are the options? What are the consequences?

06 Recommend a course of action

Provide a recommended course of action and justification.
