Fusing math, art and aesthetics, Elements incorporates Fibonacci Sequence dimensions that add an intriguing subtlety to its construction. Euclid studied the Golden Ratio 1 to 1.618 (represented by the Greek letter Phi) for its many interesting properties as described in his iconic manuscript Elements.

Those proportions were used by great artists and architects throughout the Renaissance in the form of the Golden Rectangle. Revered for its beauty, we see it in the Parthenon and in Da Vinci's portrait of the

Mona Lisa. The three intersecting planes that comprise Element's core are Golden Rectangles. Their
intersection creates 20 equilateral triangles, drawn from their points - the Platonic Solid an Icosahedron. Elements creates a thought provoking Venn diagram of Euclid, Plato, Golden Ratio, Phidias, Borromean Rings and Fibonacci.
