Wireless is very aware of the wireless LEC issue in the Western part of the State. They are working or it is just not moving fast enough. On Executive Council issues, Finances are in good shape at Nationa Legislative issues, Spectrum is a big issue right now with National. Apco is committed to doing whatev necessary to get more spectrum for Public Safety. 2005 is the date in which they want the 700 MHz fr available from the old TV spectrum. Wireless implentation is still being working on by APCO as well. stated that NC is very fortunate compaired to some other states. Other areas in the nation are still ver behind. Interference issues is another area the APCO is still very much working on. Nextel is the bigg and they have set aside 850 million to help fix this issue for public safety. Refarming is coming on 15(2005 manufactures will have to sell only 12.5 spread systems. The 25 million Nextel gave to APCO tc PSAP with wireless and other issues.
