Re: **Call for Applicants –North Carolina APCO Interim Second Vice President**

During the January 2020 Chapter Meeting, Immediate Past President Brett Wrenn and First Vice President Stephanie Conner announced they have both accepted new employment which will require them to resign their positions from the North Carolina APCO Executive Board.

Pursuant to the bylaws of the Chapter, effective February 1, 2020, the Chapter President has appointed Past President Ray Gilleland as acting Immediate Past President and Second Vice President Christine Moore will advance to the office of First Vice President where she will serve in an acting capacity until the beginning of her regular term in May 2021.

North Carolina APCO is currently seeking applicants interested in serving in an interim role as the Chapter's Acting Second Vice-President through May 2021. A nominee will be selected by the Chapter President and presented for confirmation by majority vote of the Executive Board as prescribed in bylaws. Once confirmed, the nominee will serve as the Acting Second Vice President until the next regular election of officers in May 2021 where he or she may then run for a full term in office.

Potential nominees must be a full member of North Carolina APCO and will be expected to represent the overall objectives and mission of North Carolina APCO while serving as a member of the Executive Board. Participation and attendance at all Board and bimonthly Chapter Meetings is required.

Interested applicants should submit the following:


- Current Resume
- Letter of intent – to include details of any current or previous leadership experience; and an explanation of any previous experience that has prepared you to serve on the Executive Board.

The nominee will be required to provide a letter of support of his or her agency head prior to their final confirmation. This support is vital to a nominee's success as a member of the Executive Board.




