Dear NC APCO Members,

It is with deep regret that I share with you that the Executive Board of North Carolina APCO has come to a unanimous decision that it would be in the best interest of our membership to cancel the 2020 North Carolina APCO Telecommunicator Training Symposium which had been rescheduled for October 11-14, 2020 in Greensboro, NC.

This event was originally scheduled for April 2020, and in mid-March as the COVID-19 Pandemic continued to increase, in abundance of caution for the safety of our members, the Executive Board made the decision to delay the event by six months. As the pandemic has continued to spread to all aspects of our daily lives there is much uncertainty as to how this will affect agency budgets and travel abilities, and because of this and other safety concerns, we believe our best option moving forward will be to cancel this event all together.

North Carolina APCO is committed to refunding the registration of all participants. Refunds will be processed using the same original payment method and should be completed by no later than July 1, 2020.
