5th ANNUAL BARBECUE COOK-OFF GENERAL RULES

- 1. This Cook-Off is OPEN to the PUBLIC.
- 2. This is a NON-SANCTIONED Cook-Off.
- 3. You may bring your own alcohol.
- 4. Except for the Deviled Egg competition, ALL entries must be cooked on the premises on the day of the cook-off. Cooking may begin upon completion of ingredient inspection. (Exceptions may apply for Brisket Cook-Off. See Brisket Rules).
- 5. Except for the Deviled Egg competition, ALL cooking must be done from scratch. Ingredients such as onions, etc., may be cut or chopped in advance, but must not be mixed prior to inspection.
- 6. ALL entries must be turned in, in the container issued by the Cook-Off Committee.
- 7. NO OPEN "PIT" FIRES are permitted! Propane or wood fueled grills/stoves may be used.
- 8. AT ALL TIMES, common sense sanitary conditions must prevail.
- 9. AT ALL TIMES, cooking area must be kept clean and free of litter. Garbage bags will be provided.
- 10. When breaking down your booth and leaving the cook-off area, remove everything that was brought in. This includes any lumber, hay bales, etc. If it was not there when you arrived, it should not be there when you leave.

COOK-OFF PARTICIPANTS ARE EXPECTED TO CONDUCT THEMSELVES IN A COURTEOUS AND PROFESSIONAL MANNER. DISORDERLY CONDUCT BY ANY TEAM MEMBER COULD LEAD TO THE DISQUALIFICATION OF THE ENTIRE TEAM. THE HEAD COOKS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ACTIONS OF THEIR TEAM.
