

Integrated Neighbourhood Team

The Integrated Neighbourhood Manager (INM) Pretty Wilkinson, is designed to lead the integration of health and care staff working within each neighbourhood and implement integrated working whilst designing the care around the needs of people. The team works in partnership with the Primary Care Network Clinical Director, bringing together organisations and groups that can play a part in identifying and delivering key health outcomes for the Neighbourhood.



The INM approach is to shift the pattern of care and services to be preventative, proactive and local whilst being inclusive of the community needs across all age groups. Working collaboratively with the GP practices within the neighbourhood and hospital teams in preventing frequent GP attendance, hospital admissions and improving discharge and patient care in the community by :

- Ensure that people in the community have the right support in the right place with the appropriate service for their needs at the right time.
- Enabling extensive local Neighbourhood engagement, involvement and ensuring the local community are actively engaged in developing Integrated Neighbourhood working.
- Utilise health population, local intelligence and activity data to drive priority settings, service redesign and evaluations.
- To lead, influence, shape and work with a number of local community partners, both statutory and non-statutory responsible for the people living in the neighbourhood.
- Fostering a culture of collaboration, innovation and establishing a more stream lined approach to the delivery of care to patients and the wider community support; is maximised in support of the person at the centre of care.

This will include working with and coordinating the efforts of:

- Community nurses
- Community therapists
- Social prescribers
- Community mental health workers
- Social workers
- Voluntary sector leads
- Charity sector leads
