

Dear Campus Community,

This semester we have updated our parking permit process with a more convenient and efficient system, eliminating the use of daily parking permit machines.

What's Changed:

- **Daily Permit Machines Disabled:** We will no longer use on-campus machines to purchase daily permits.
- **New QR Code & Website System:** Daily permits are now purchased online by scanning a QR code (below) posted in campus parking areas at the locations of the old machines, or by visiting our parking permit website at <https://mycampuspermit.com/delta-college> (see screenshot below)
- **No Paper Daily Permit Required:** You no longer need to display a paper daily permit on your dashboard.

Important Reminder:

When purchasing a daily permit, **you must enter your license plate number accurately** in the system. Failure to do so may result in a citation.

Also, if you forgot to affix your **semester parking permit** to your windshield, make sure your license plate details are accurately entered into the My Campus Permit system. All license plates are checked in the system prior to issuing a citation.

Parking Permit Process

Parking permit fees are \$30 for a student semester permit and \$2 for a daily permit.

Semester Parking Permits can be obtained through Insite or MyCampusPermit.com.

Daily Parking Permits may be purchased from Ticket Dispensers for \$2 a day. Ticket dispensers are located in the parking lots.

Semester and daily permits must be displayed in plain view with all numbers and markings clearly visible.

Failure to obtain and display a valid parking permit will result in a citation. For help with your permit, call 1-800-700-4417 or visit MyCampusPermit.com.

Students, staff, and faculty will need to provide their vehicle license plate number, make, and color of the vehicle. If you will be driving a different vehicle during the term, you will need to update your vehicle information [HERE](#) or call 1-800-700-4417 BEFORE parking on campus.
