The Starting Line

Initially, Kristen Hosman worked as a controller at a large manufacturing company that ran on QuickBooks and then moved to Microsoft Dynamics GP. With this experience, she began working for a Microsoft Dynamics Partner and then struck out independently as a consultant, assisting multiple Partners with complex projects.



In 2022, Kristen faced a fork in the road and decided that Mount Evans Consulting should become a reselling Microsoft Partner. The legal requirements were an uphill climb, but she stuck with it and has never looked back.

Her first client was Power Platform expert Mary Myers at WorldMax.

The Trail: QuickBooks to Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central

At this point, it made sense for her to start using Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central to run her own business. For the first couple of years, the needs were strictly AP, AR, and Banking.

Kristen and her first employee, Crystal, managed their billable time in Excel.

Then she asked other friends, "Who is running their business on QuickBooks and needs a new ERP?"

Immediately, she moved two companies, including <u>Evaporative Solutions</u>, from QuickBooks to Dynamics BC.

The largest client Mount Evans Consulting started working with in 2022 was a holding company that used QuickBooks to manage 18 Wingstop franchise locations and \$20 million in revenue. They were live on Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central in four weeks.

Route Marker 1: Time Tracking with Clockify Integration

When Mount Evans Consulting added a second full-time employee, they started using Clockify for time tracking and project billing.

They could now see reports of billable hours and no longer had to create weekly sales invoices manually from Excel. While Clockify does not have a native integration with Business Central, Kristen worked with Stefan Maron, who built a <u>Clockify Integration</u> that is now used by many Business Central customers.





Route Marker 2: Subscription Billing from Binary Stream

Once Mount Evans Consulting went from billing for services only to selling licenses, they added the <u>Subscription Billing Suite by Binary Stream</u>.

This application allows them to track and manage the subscriptions they sell and quickly create invoices.

Route Marker 3: Financial Reporting from Cosmos

The cloud reporting and analytics solution from Cosmos gives Mount Evans Consulting more powerful financial reporting.

Route Marker 4: Custom Tools

Because Mount Evans Consulting knows what QuickBooks users want, the team has built its own tools to make the transition easier.

The first tool brings GL history from QuickBooks into Business Central. Another tool allows Business Central users to set up schedules to email reports to specific users.
