



STAY HEALTHY AFTER A FLOOD

- ► Mold and indoor air quality. Mold growth may be a risk if your home flooded. Reduce the risk of mold growth by taking the following steps:
 - Make sure electrical and gas systems are not hazardous and functioning properly before using!
 - Remove as much standing water as possible from floors, carpets, etc.
 - Remove any wet materials that can't be dried within 48 hours.
 - Flooded basements should be emptied by only one-third of the volume each day, beginning once surrounding floodwaters have receded.
 - Dry the inside of the house. Open windows, closets, doors, the attic, eaves and other vents.
 - Warm the house at least 15 degrees higher than the outside temperature.

- Remove baseboards and drill/punch holes in the wall 2 inches above the floor to dry areas between walls.
- ► Avoid Carbon Monoxide (CO) poisoning during power outages. Using alternative sources of fuel for heat, cooking or electricity can cause CO to build up in enclosed spaces. It is odorless & poisonous to people and pets:
 - Do not use BBQs, propane heaters, generators or gas ranges indoors.
 - Have a battery-operated CO detector in your home.
 - Symptoms of CO exposure include headache, dizziness, weakness, nausea/vomiting, chest pain and confusion.







SPICY SWEET POTATO & BLACK BEAN CHILI

One of my most requested dishes! It's hearty, healthy, and delicious! Serve with a side of corn bread or corn tortilla chips! The perfect meal to warm you up on a fall day!

INGREDIENTS: 2 T. extra-virgin olive oil; 1 lg. sweet potato, peeled & diced; 1 med. Walla Walla onion, diced; 4 cloves garlic, minced; 1 T. chili powder; 1 T. ground cumin; 1/2 tsp. chipotle chili pepper; 1/4 tsp. cayenne pepper; 1/2 tsp. salt; 2 1/2 c. vegetable broth or water; 2 (15 oz.) cans black beans, drained and rinsed; 1 (14 oz.) can diced tomatoes; 2 T. fresh lime juice; 1/2 c. fresh cilantro, chopped; Lime wedges for serving

DIRECTIONS: 1. In a large heavy bottom pot, heat olive oil over medium-high heat. Add sweet potatoes and onions. Cook, stirring often, until the onions begin to soften and turn translucent, about 4-5 minutes. 2. Add garlic, chili powder, cumin, chipotle chili pepper, cayenne pepper and salt. Cook, stirring constantly for 30 seconds. 3. Add vegetable broth or water, bring to a simmer. Reduce heat and simmer until the sweet potatoes are tender, about 10 minutes. 4. Add black beans and diced tomatoes. Increase heat to medium-high and return to a simmer, stirring often. Reduce heat and continue to simmer for about 5 minutes. 5. Remove from heat and stir in lime juice and cilantro. Ladle chili into bowls. Serve with corn bread or tortilla chips and lime wedges. 6. Cook's Note: Occasionally, I like to add 10 ounces of fresh or frozen corn in step 4.



OPPOSING PLANETS

Our closest solar system neighbors offer a wealth of viewing opportunities and are usually very easy to find. The Moon and Sun (more on the Sun later) are obvious targets, both offering ever changing views, the Moon as light crossed across its face and the Sun as a boiling cauldron of activity. The planets also offer stunning vistas, but their movement makes certain times better than others. When a planet is in "opposition" it means it is closest to us and time for a peak. Planets closer to the Sun than we are can be best viewed when at "greatest elongation" which means angled farthest from the Sun from our point of view. Sometimes the interior planets pass in front of the Sun, called a "transit". The next Venus transit won't happen until 2117, but Mercury transits are a bit more common. So if you hear a planet is in opposition it doesn't mean the Martians are invading, its just time to go outside and take a peak.
