
### **“THE WOMEN WHO HELPED SHAPE ABRAHAM LINCOLN”**

## ST. PATRICK'S DAY ACTIVITY: COIN DIG!

For an easy to put together St. Patrick's Day activity, try this shaving cream sensory coin dig! The kids had fun digging with their hands to find the leprechaun gold. Be warned – this is definitely not a mess free activity! But I do share cleaning tips below to help you out!

**MAKE YOUR GOLD COIN DIG:** Shaving cream; 3-4 drops green food coloring; green glitter; Gold coins; Clear dish; Spoon; Paper towels (just to have handy)

**DIRECTIONS:** Fill a clear dish (we used a big glass bowl) about 3/4 of the way with shaving cream, and add 3-4 drops of green food coloring. Shake in some glitter, and stir! Stir in the gold coins (we got ours from the dollar store). I added some more glitter to the top. Then set it out for a sensory coin dig! My kids were happy to dig through with their hands, but sometimes they want to ease into the touch of shaving cream. For that, I simply give them spoons!

**CLEANING TIPS:** 1. Have the paper towels and a bowl of water nearby. I used both during the activity, because at various points my kids wanted their hands cleaned. Also, my toddler kept touching his face, and I wanted to wipe it off right away. It also definitely helped to have paper towels and water after! 2. I put the kids in smocks and old clothes – although the green did wash out from both their clothes and their hands (and their hair!). It will probably depend on how much food coloring you use and what type! You could also try this using washable green paint. 3. I'd also recommend putting down a drop cloth (maybe next I'll actually use one!)



In retrospect, I can only conclude that my parents must have failed miserably in raising me. I base this conclusion on the fact that I appear to have a unique talent for unwittingly offending other people – and not just Crab Cracker readers because of my latest column. Let me provide a few examples to explain how horrible an adult I turned out to be. All of the following are true stories.

On one occasion, I was visiting another sibling for a week. We were planning to catch a minor league baseball game the following evening. But the morning of the game, I received a call from one of my closest friends – who I had not seen in years. They were only in town for one night – the same night as the game. So, without thinking, I replied, "Sure, I'd love to see you tonight."

I then explained to my sibling my change of plans. Even though we could catch another game the following evening and I'd be here for four more days, the mistake I made was in choosing my friend over my sibling without consulting them first. My unilateral change of plans could only be interpreted one way: I clearly must care for my friend more than my family member, and I must not respect my sibling. As a result of my terribly insensitive spur-of-the-moment decision, they refused to talk to me for four months – despite roughly half a dozen emails and a similar number of voicemails in which I tried to apologize.

Not long ago, I wrote a serious, reflective article about the special people who had most influenced my life for the better. I wrote from the heart. It had almost no jokes (much like this article – sorry). But I learned later that one of my siblings about whom I sang their praises was slightly hurt because – and I am not making this up – they counted the words in my description about their influence on my life and noticed it was shorter than my commentary about some of the other people I had written about. They interpreted this the only logical way any reasonable person could: My love and appreciation for the important people in my life can accurately be calculated by my word count.



Then there was the time I lent one of my siblings \$500 on the condition they pay me back in three months. They agreed and thanked me for helping them out in a pinch. But I wanted to spend Thanksgiving in Albany, to visit my mom (my parents were divorced) and some of my high school cronies. My father went so far as to book my roundtrip airline reservations from Charlottesville, VA to Columbus, changing planes at Dulles Airport outside of DC. I disobeyed my stern father's direct mandate and flew to Albany anyway. My egocentric impudence was met with understandable parental fury and threats of cutting me off financially.

Interesting thing about that weekend. It turns out that the December 1st TWA return flight my father had booked me on after Thanksgiving, from Columbus to DC crashed, killing everyone on the flight. (True.) Had I complied with my father's orders, you would not be reading this article today. Nevertheless, my father was still angry at me for not sufficiently apologizing for being so rude as to ignore his charge and go to Albany instead. To be honest, I'm not exactly sure how I would have worded my apology: "Sorry I am still alive to say I'm sorry, dad?"

Like I said, I have a long history of being a selfish, insensitive person. Just ask one of my siblings. And for that, I apologize.... again...



## JON KEVIN BLACKBURN

Unique Raku and soda fired urns for your cherished cremation remains, handcrafted in Stanwood and Camano Island. Inspired by Earth's mountains, oceans, trees and rocks, and all of their colors, forms and textures, I use my hands, clay and fire to make urns for cremated remains.


Each urn is a one-of-a-kind, made by using the Raku and soda ash style of firing. These two methods of kiln firing are unpredictable and during the process each urn is subject to marvelous possibilities, duplicating nature inspired textures and colors. After firing, each urn comes out of the kiln always different, interesting and surprising and each invites you to look and feel.

I incorporate what I observe in nature, the subtle colors and patterns, sometimes organized, sometimes random. I like that in my work. I try to control to a certain degree, but only so far. Each urn inside the kiln will do what it needs to do . . . and the fire has the final say.

The first urns I started working on were a direct result of the death of my father in 1996. His passing and cremation got me thinking about precious vessels and ceremonial urns, the type that could be used for cremated remains. The first urns were large and temple-like. Some had wood and clay "temple houses" for the urn to sit in. I wanted the urns to have an aged, ancient look or feeling, including a sense of the spiritual or mystical. Others were supported on legs of clay molded into organic shapes such as bones, wood carvings, carved bone and antlers. These pieces had wooden lids that were covered with gold leaf and could be fastened down with wing type wood flaps, sealing whatever precious contents were inside. I have simplified my approach and now incorporate a simple leather attachment system to hold the lids in place and the contents secure. I hope you take the time to browse through the variety of urns I am offering and find that special one for your beloved.







## SUPPORTING ANIMALS IN NEED

CASA (Camano Animal Shelter Association) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization and managed-admission and no-kill shelter devoted to the care of homeless pets. Our mission is "bringing together animals in need and caring people, forever enriching their lives." We accept stray dogs and cats from Camano Island and owner-surrenders from Camano and elsewhere as space permits. Additionally, through a limited contract with Island County we provide temporary care, boarding and redemption services for impounded/seized dogs from Camano Island. CASA recognizes that finding forever homes for homeless animals is a community effort. We regularly assist other shelters by taking dogs that have been at their shelter for a prolonged period of time and/or could really benefit from a change of environment or different exposure, or because the shelter is struggling with overcrowding. We also work with a variety of rescue groups in order to transfer animals to them when they need more specialized care prior to finding a forever home. Thanks to the ongoing support from the community, CASA was able to care for almost 400 lost, abandoned and surrendered cats and dogs in 2021. Our shelter space may be limited, but so much of our life saving effort takes place outside of our building in the homes of devoted foster parents who prepare them for adoption. We have a number of adoption specials throughout the year and every single animal that is adopted from us will go home spayed or neutered and micro-chipped. Our cats are also FeLV/FIV tested. After adoption CASA still cares about the animals that come from us. If you adopt a pet from us, remember we are here to help you with ongoing questions and you are always able to return your pet back to CASA in the event you can no longer care for them. Although the pandemic has eliminated browsing for now and requires appointments for shelter services, we are pleased to say that the care and placement of animals continues the same as before. We are overjoyed that CASA is still here to help take in animals that need our care and then get a second chance at happiness and a forever home. All of CASA's adoptable animals can be viewed on our website, as well as the animals on stray hold in the event you have recently lost an animal in our area. ## Are You Volcano Ready?

Beautiful Mount Baker erupted most recently in 1843, but in 1975 surprised everyone with renewed steaming, which continues today. As in past millennia, future eruptions can release volcanic mudflows (lahars) that inundate valleys far downstream and ash fall that can blanket the landscape.

- Get to know your local volcano's hazards

## **DRIVER SAFETY FOR OLDER ADULTS**



## OVEN ROASTED CORNED BEEF AND CABBAGE

Our tender corned beef brisket with roasted potatoes, carrots, and cabbage is so flavorful, you'll never boil it again!

**INGREDIENTS:** 4 lbs. corned beef brisket with seasoning packet; 2 T. whole grain mustard; 6-8 med. red potatoes cut into 1" wedges; 4-5 med. carrots peeled, cut into 1" pieces; 1 head cabbage cut into 8 wedges; 2 T. extra virgin olive oil; Kosher salt and black pepper for seasoning; 1 c. chicken broth

**INSTRUCTIONS:** 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Rinse corned beef brisket under cold water and pat dry with paper towels. 2. Place corned beef brisket into a large roasting pan, fat side up. Spread mustard evenly over the top of the brisket and sprinkle with the contents of seasoning packet. Tightly cover the roasting pan with aluminum foil and place in oven for 2 1/2 hours. 3. Place potatoes and carrots in a large bowl; drizzle with olive oil and season with salt and pepper, toss to coat. Drizzle olive oil over cabbage wedges; season with salt and pepper. 4. Remove the roasting pan from the oven. Carefully remove the foil and pour the chicken broth around the corned beef. Evenly place seasoned carrots and potatoes around the brisket and top with cabbage wedges. Tightly seal pan with aluminum foil and return to oven for 1 1/2 to 2 hours. 5. Remove brisket from pan and loosely tent with aluminum foil. Let rest 15 minutes. Slice brisket and serve with veggies.



## WEATHER IN OUR SOLAR SYSTEM

With our cloudy winter you likely still have a backlog for visual observing so let's talk a bit more about weather in our solar system. Last time we covered the climate on Venus and Mars. The outer planets also experience weather, but if you thought Venus and Mars were bad I'm afraid the forecast won't be much better. The gas giants of Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus and Neptune don't really have a solid surface and storms there can rage well beyond the few miles of atmosphere we think about when it comes to weather. Storms with 600+ MPH winds can continue for years such as the The Great Red Spot on Jupiter, a massive hurricane like system that has existed for centuries or longer. Bring a sweater with your windbreaker because temperatures range between -202 degrees to -328 degrees Fahrenheit on these outer planets.

Many of the outer moons also have atmospheres with weather. On Titan, a moon of Saturn, the current forecast is cloudy with a chance of rain, but its not water, its liquid methane. Again, bring a sweater because the temperature is around -300 degrees F. Titan's surface and sky can be seen in the picture above.

Europa, a moon of Jupiter, has a different type of forecast. Because Europa has only a very thin atmosphere, a crust of solid ice, and liquid oceans under that crust, weather is perhaps best predicted by oceanographers. A forecast on Europa could read "Rising currents from volcanic vents will give way to a general warming trend in the southeast regions 200 miles above the ocean floor"... Not too suitable for humans.

So the next time it seems a bit too rainy/grey/cold/hot/windy remember we live on the only spot in our solar system that wouldn't kill you in minutes or even seconds. We are on a very small oasis and should be very careful to protect it.


