



Since it is a natural product; inherently there are imperfections resulting from such things as range scars, bug bites, brands and naturally occurring variations in skin color, thickness, surface conditions and blemishes. I select the very best sections from the hides for my tooling however, sometimes an imperfection will be present in one of my finished pieces. 

#### CANDY CORN FUDGE

Orange, lemon, and vanilla flavored white chocolate fudge shaped as candy corns. How cute is that!?!

YELLOW LAYER: 1 (12 oz.) pkg. white chocolate chips; 1/4 c. heavy whipping cream; 1 tsp. lemon extract; Wilton yellow gel food color ORANGE LAYER: 1 (12 oz.) pkg. white chocolate chips; 1/4 c. heavy whipping cream; 1 tsp. orange extract; Wilton orange gel food color WHITE LAYER: 1 (12 oz.) pkg. white chocolate chips; 1/4 c. heavy whipping cream; 1 tsp. clear vanilla extract

DIRECTIONS: Line a 9x5-inch loaf pan with foil. Leave foil hanging over two sides of the pan for easy removal. Lightly spray the foil with cooking spray. YELLOW LAYER: Combine white chips, heavy whipping cream, and lemon extract in a medium-size microwave safe bowl. Microwave for 30 seconds on high heat. Stir. Repeat and stir. until chips are melted and smooth. Add the food color and stir until color is uniform. You may need to add more food color to achieve your desired shade. Spread the mixture evenly over the prepared pan and chill for 30 minutes. ORANGE LAYER: Combine white chips, heavy whipping cream, and orange extract in a medium-size microwave safe bowl. Microwave for 30 seconds on high heat. Stir. Repeat and stir until chips are melted and smooth. Add the food color and stir until color is uniform. You may need to add more food color to achieve your desired shade. Spread the mixture evenly over the chilled yellow layer and chill for 30 minutes. WHITE LAYER: Combine white chips heavy whipping cream, and clear vanilla in a medium-size microwave safe bowl. Microwave for 30 seconds on high heat. Stir. Repeat and stir until chips are melted and smooth. Spread the mixture evenly over the chilled orange layer and chill for at least 2 hours. Use a knife to loosen the fudge from the two ends without foil. Remove the fudge from the pan using the foil as handles. Cut the fudge into 1/2-inch slices and then into wedges or triangles so that they resemble candy corn. Store leftovers in an airtight container in the refrigerator for up to 1 week. Yields 2.25 lbs candy


