
CHRISTMAS ADIOS







THIS HOLIDAY SEASON, GIVE THE GIFT OF GUILT

What comes to mind when you hear the phrase, the spirit of Christmas? When I was young, my notion was so naïve. Like many children, I believed Santa and his reindeer flew around the world on Christmas Eve, bringing presents to all the children. But then I turned 25, and I began to question this narrative. Eventually I realized Santa traveling the world with eight reindeer was, of course, a ridiculous notion. He'd need far more than eight reindeer even in the best of weather conditions.

Now that I'm older, I know Santa doesn't deliver the presents (well, not most of them anyway). People do. I've learned the spirit of the Holiday Season is first and foremost about people buying gifts for other people – and the Black Friday fight fest to see who grabs the last 60% off flat screen TV – you or that jerk with the mullet haircut and a T-shirt that reads "Recall Santa. I didn't get what I wanted."

I've discovered – mainly from watching my drunken relatives – that Christmas is about ensuring that the recipient knows damn well how incredibly thoughtful your gift is, compared to their lame attempt. Studies show most gifts will be forgotten within 48 hours – never to be seen again until next spring's garage sale – or re-gifted to a co-worker at the next office Holiday Party. So why not get into the true spirit of the season by giving instead a gift they'll remember for years – the gift of guilt? By selecting just the right item, you can ensure the recipient will feel obligated to reciprocate – in the anxious hope you won't figure out that they never intended to buy you a present.

Let's say you've learned that your wife plans to give you for Christmas a pair of scissors with a built-in tape dispenser. Talk about mailing it in, right? So, what should you get her in return? Might I suggest a lovely ceramic charm bracelet from Tiffany's? The perfect holiday way to say, "I guess we know who loves who more in this relationship, eh?" Sure, she will have received the far better gift. But think about how quilty she'll feel. Well played, buddy.

When it comes to the spirit of Christmas, I need to say a word about thank-you cards. First of all, don't expect any for the thoughtful gifts you gave. People stopped writing thank-you cards in 1994. If you're lucky, you might get a two-syllable Facebook message saying "Hey, Thx!" It's important to make clear who the better person is, and that means you should write a plausibly sincere thank-you note – or at least, a thank-you text. After all, someone apparently went to a lot of effort to select just the perfect gift for you, by which of course, I'm referring to that slightly stained coffee mug they re-gifted with the hilarious phrase "I hate Mondays."

GINGERBREAD WAFFLES

A Christmas morning tradition in our family, we serve these delicious waffles with a side of bacon and/or sausage and a plate of fresh fruit. Makes wonderful pancakes too!!

WAFFLES: 3 c. all-purpose flour; 4 tsp. baking powder; 2 tsp. ground cinnamon; 2 tsp. ground ginger; 1/2 tsp. ground nutmeg; 1/2 tsp. salt; 4 lg. eggs; 2/3 c. brown sugar, packed; 1 c. canned 100% pure pumpkin; 1 1/4 c. evaporated milk; 1/2 c. molasses; 1/2 c. melted butter, plus more for iron

TOPPINGS: Warm maple syrup for serving; Chopped pecans for serving; Whipped cream for serving; Fresh fruit for serving

DIRECTIONS: 1. In a large bowl, whisk together flour, baking powder, cinnamon, ginger, nutmeg and salt; set aside. 2. In a medium bowl, beat together eggs and brown sugar until light and fluffy, then beat in pumpkin, milk, molasses and melted butter. Gently fold egg mixture into the flour mixture, until moist. Do not over stir the waffle batter. The batter will be thick in consistency. 3. Preheat your waffle iron according to manufacturer's directions. (I used a Belgian waffle iron.). 4. Brush the waffle iron with a little melted butter, scoop about a 1/4 to 1/2 cup batter onto the waffle iron and cook according to manufacturer's directions. Repeat with remaining batter. 5. Top the waffles with warm maple syrup, chopped pecans, and whipped cream or fresh fruit if desired. Serves 6-8.






