SUPPORTING ANIMALS IN NEED

CASA (Camano Animal Shelter Association) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization and managed-admission and no-kill shelter devoted to the care of homeless pets. Our mission is "bringing together animals in need and caring people, forever enriching their lives." We accept stray dogs and cats from Camano Island and owner-surrenders from Camano and elsewhere as space permits. Additionally, through a limited contract with Island County we provide temporary care, boarding and redemption services for impounded/seized dogs from Camano Island. CASA recognizes that finding forever homes for homeless animals is a community effort. We regularly assist other shelters by taking dogs and cats that have been at their shelter for a prolonged time and/or could really benefit from a change of environment or different exposure, or because the shelter is struggling with overcrowding. We also work with a variety of rescue groups in transferring animals that need more specialized care prior to finding a forever home. Thanks to the ongoing support from the community, CASA was able to care for almost 500 lost, abandoned and surrendered cats and dogs in 2022. Our shelter space may be limited, but much of our life saving effort takes place outside of our building in the homes of devoted foster parents who prepare the animals for adoption. We have adoption specials throughout the year and every single animal that is adopted from us will go home spayed or neutered and microchipped. Our cats are also FeLV/FIV tested. After adoption CASA still cares about the animals that come from us. If you adopt a pet from us, remember we are here to help you with ongoing questions and you are always able to return your pet back to CASA in the event you can no longer care for them. We are overjoyed that CASA is here to take in animals and provide them a second chance at happiness and a forever home. All of CASA's adoptable animals and the animals on stray hold (in the event you have recently lost an animal in our area) are viewable on our website, www.camanoanimalshelter.org. We invite you to visit the shelter to learn about volunteer opportunities and see firsthand how your support helps the animals in our care.

POTATOES: 5 lg. Russet or Yukon gold potatoes, cleaned and sliced; 1/4 c. olive oil; Salt and black pepper to taste

NACHOS: 2 c. shredded cheddar cheese; 1/2 c. chopped cooked corned beef or bacon; 4 green onions, sliced; 1 Roma tomato, seeded and chopped; Tamed pickled jalapenos; Sour cream for serving; Guacamole for serving

DIRECTIONS: 1. POTATOES: Using a mandolin or sharp knife, slice potatoes 1/4-inch thick and place in a large bowl of cold water for 20 minutes. Drain and pat dry with paper towels. 2. Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Line 2 rimmed baking sheets with parchment paper OR spray with nonstick spray. 3. In a large bowl, toss potatoes with olive oil and a hefty pinch of salt and black pepper. Place the potato slices on the prepared baking sheets in a single layer (do not overlap) and bake for 20 minutes. Remove the baking sheets from the oven and flip the potatoes over. Bake for an additional 15-20 minutes or until browned and crispy. 4. NACHOS: Increase the oven temperature to 475 degrees. 5. Layer the baked potato slices in an oven proof skillet or baking dish (a pie plate works well for this too). Top with shredded cheddar cheese, bacon or corned beef, and green onions. Repeat the layers until you've used up all your potatoes, reserving a few green onions for garnish. 6. Bake for 5-10 minutes or until the cheese is melted. 7. Remove from the oven and top with reserved green onions, diced tomato, and Jalapenos. Serve with sour cream and guacamole for dipping.
