



## MAKE YOUR OWN SOLAR OVEN

Use the power of the sun to cook up some tasty treats this summer!

### WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Cardboard box (a pizza box will work best)
- · Aluminum foil
- · Plastic Wrap
- · Scissors
- · Glue
- · Ruler or wood dowel
- · Paper Plate





### HOW TO DO IT:

- 1. Cut a flap on the top of your box leaving a 1-2" border around the edges.
- Next, wrap the inside of the box and bottom of the flap you cut out with aluminum foil. Make sure the foil is shinu side up! Secure with tape.
- Cover the hole created by the flap with plastic wrap. Use tape to hold in place. This will create a protected space for the food you decide to cook.
- 4. Set up your oven. Use the ruler or wood dowel to hold up the flap and place in the sun.
- Find some food to cook we recommend making some baked in the sun s'mores or a solar pizza and get started! Set on a plate inside your solar oven. Remember to remove carefully, your solar powered creations will be hot!

Tip: Keep in mind that the solar oven will be a little slower than a regular oven. Cooking times will vary based on time of day, temperature, and where you place your oven. Make some delicious creations by changing some of these variables!









## **FAWN SEASON**



"Dear Friends, We just received our first phone call regarding newborn fawns, therefore it is the time of the year to post this. Deer deliver their newborns in the strangest of places! Residents will find them and be concerned about a newborn deer on their lawn, in their garden, under the azaleas, etc. Most call because they think the fawn is in peril and Mom is nowhere to be found. Well, Mom is actually off feeding and helping to keep predators away. Those who call ask what they should do for the fawn ... Leave it alone, do not touch, move or attempt to feed it. Here's the scoop. Deer are NOT like horses. They do not have their legs under them immediately and need time to rest after birth. Horses get up and go that's the sign of a healthy horse. A healthy fawn will curl up, nap most of the day and move their heads. They have no scent and predators cannot find them unless humans interfere. Mom leaves during the day for 2 primary reasons: to feed. and to keep her scent a distance from the fawn. Mom will come back (unless something tragic happens to her), but don't expect her until dusk and certainly don't expect her if humans are hovering around. If you are fortunate enough to have the gift of a fawn please enjoy the experience, respect Mother Nature and let the Mom do what comes naturally. 

# Cooking Mamas

**GREEK ORZO SALAD** 

A delightful pasta salad loaded with Mediterranean flavors! Serve as a side salad or main dish. Perfect for picnics, potlucks and BBQ's!



GREEK DRESSING: 1/4 c. extra-virgin olive oil; 1/4 c. red wine vinegar; 1 T. fresh lemon juice; 1/2 tsp. Dijon mustard; 1 clove garlic pressed; 1 tsp. oregano; 1/2 tsp. sea salt; Freshly ground black pepper

PASTA: 1 1/4 c. (8 oz) dry orzo

SALAD: 1 English cucumber halved vertically, seeded, & sliced ¼-inch thick; 1 (10 oz. cont.) grape or cherry tomatoes halved; 1/4 red onion thinly sliced; 1 (16 oz.) can low-sodium chickpeas drained and rinsed; 1 c. pitted Kalamata olives; 4 oz. feta cheese broken into pieces; 1 c. fresh basil leaves torn and divided; Sea salt and freshly ground black pepper to taste

DIRECTIONS: 1. DRESSING: In a small jar, combine olive oil, red wine vinegar, lemon juice, mustard, garlic, oregano, salt, and several grinds of pepper. Cover with a lid and shake until combined, set aside. 2. PASTA: Bring a large pot of salted water to a boil. Cook pasta according to package directions or until al dente. Drain and rinse pasta under cold water. Spread the orzo on a rimmed baking sheet, toss with a little olive oil (so it doesn't stick together) and allow to cool. 3. Meanwhile, prep veggies. 4. SALAD: In a large bowl, toss together cooled pasta, cucumbers, tomatoes, red onion, chickpeas, and olives. Drizzle with the dressing, add half the basil, feta, and season with sea salt and freshly ground black pepper; toss to coat. Garnish with remaining basil and serve. 5. Note: If you want to make the salad ahead to save time, simply add the basil and feta just before serving. You may want to add a drizzle of olive oil too, Enjoy!
