DOG POUND BLUES

In the winter of what must have been '74 I'd quit my job running food service at the University of Wisconsin's Student Union, fed up with middle management and bored with the place after 3 months. After a few months of laying low I ended up looking for a dog at the local Humane Society and noticed a job opening for kennel worker, which, after a moment's reflection, I applied for and got, maybe not the best career move for a 24 year old with a degree in English and Sociology, but then again, how better to apply that sociology than take a variety of odd jobs, study from the inside, maybe even find an occupation most suited to my skills and interests.

Shoveling excrement and killing critters might not seem to some a ladder up, but trust me, I was sick of management. If you're looking to climb to the top, why not start at the bottom rung, even half way up will look like success. I had a partner, Larry, who'd been busted for selling LSD to undercover federal narcs, spent a year in jail, now he was pretty much unemployable as a felon. The dog pound didn't care so long as we showed up most of the time, which we did. Mary Ann covered the cat pens and we handled the puppies and dogs. Up front Mike was manager, Mary Jane assistant and Pat was secretary. We ran a tight little ship, taking in unwanted pets, adopting out what we could, euthanizing what we couldn't. You see those heart wrenching ads now on TV, sappy music playing, mistreated hounds with sad eyes staring out at you, that was us, the Humane Society.

Our building sat a block or two from a tavern that had refused to sell to the Oscar Mayer wiener company so the hot dog czars fenced off their factory with the bar inside the perimeter, figuring it wouldn't take long before the recalcitrant owners gave up and sold the place for a parking spot for their Wienermobiles. Hard nose capitalism. Larry and I started walking down there for our lunch break, grab a burger and slam a couple of beers before returning to the killing floor. By spring our attitudes had taken a turn for the cynical, partly due to a fight we had with the Board of the Society over a pay raise we'd gone on strike for, us and Mary Jane, the three of us walking out if we didn't get a quarter more over our 2 buck hourly. The Board balked and Mike, realizing he'd be doing the shoveling solo, intervened on our behalf.

But the animosity was palpable afterwards and every day Larry and I would stay a little longer at the tavern. Mike was about our age, a pretty decent boss overall, and he put up with our tardiness up to a point, but finally he would walk down to fetch us and for awhile we would agree to come back. But not until he had a beer with us. All three of us could see where this was heading and none of it was good. Larry quit first and the Board, instead of hiring a replacement, used volunteers, animal lovers being easy to find, athough maybe not the best workers. Mary Jane left next and of course I followed shortly after, all of us gone in less than a week.

When I came back a year later to see the place, the pens were filthy and the puppies covered in their own poop, probably not really a great presentation for potential adopters. Mike was gone and so was Pat, leaving only Mary Ann to head up the place, the woman none of us liked. But ... the tavern inside the sausage plant was still there. For old times sake I wandered over for one last beer. And for the first time I noticed that they didn't have hot dogs on the menu.





CONSTRUCTION ALONG I-5 OVER SECRET CREEK NEAR STANWOOD IS COMING SOON

Over the next two years, beginning this February, WSDOT will remove the smaller, aging culverts (fish passage barriers) under both directions of I-5 and Old Highway 99 and install three new fish-approved bridge structures to enable safe fish and wildlife passage under the freeway and highway. During construction, northbound and southbound I-5 will both shift over to a two-lane, temporary bypass along the mainline until the end of December 2025. This will bring I-5 in each direction from three lanes, down to two and decrease the speed limit in the area from 70 mph to 60 mph. In 2026, construction will switch over to Old Highway 99, which will be closed for part of the year and a detour will be in place.
