

## The Village Quilters - Quilt Show 2024 Quilt Entry Rules

## To successfully register your quilt(s) you will need the following:

- Your name, phone number, and email address
- The name of your longarm quilter (if any) as well as the name of any pattern you used and the pattern designer.
- Quilt dimensions (width and length).
- The category in which the quilt should be shown:

Category Number	Category	Definition of Category
1	Pieced Quilt One Person	Made by one person. Pieced by hand or machine wall or bed quilt. Does not include paper pieced quilts.
2	Pieced Quilt Quilted by Another	Quilted by another. Pieced by hand or machine wall or bed quilt. Does not include paper pieced quilts. Must be submitted by maker of the quilt top.
3	Paper Pieced Quilt One Person	Made by one person. Paper Pieced using foundation paper wall or bed quilt.
4	Paper Pieced Quilted by Another	Quilted by another. Paper Pieced – using foundation paper wall or bed quilt. Must be submitted by maker of the quilt top.
5	Appliqué One person	Made by one person, Appliqué wall or bed quilt. Must be predominately appliquéd by either hand or machine.
6	Appliqué Quilted by Another	Quilted by another, Appliqué wall or bed quilt. Must be predominantly appliquéd by either hand or machine. Must be submitted by the maker of the quilt top.
7	Multiple Techniques	The quilt must include a balanced variety of media (i.e., appliqué, piecing, embroidery, beading, etc.) Wall or bed quilt. May be quilted by maker of the quilt top or by another.
8	Art Quilt	Must be designed by the quilt creator and present an original idea or interpretation of artwork from another medium. Wall or bed quilt. May be quilted by maker of the quilt top or by another. Must be 88.5" or greater in perimeter.
9	Specialty Items	This category includes miniature quilts (less than 88" in perimeter), wearables, purses, bowls, table runners and other miscellaneous items. Must be submitted by the person who did the predominant amount of work on the piece.

- Except for Category 9 (Specialty Items) submitted quilts must consist of three (3) layers; top, batting, and backing.
- Wall Quilts may be no smaller than an 88.5" in perimeter and no larger than 256" in perimeter.
- Bed quilts are 256.5" and larger in perimeter.



## The Village Quilters - Quilt Show 2024 Quilt Entry Rules

- A digital photo of the quilt, or partially completed quilt, to be uploaded during registration.
  - **NOTE:** Work in progress is acceptable for the photo. Photos are for staging purposes and will not be returned. Photos of your quilt may be used to publicize the show.
- An acceptable form of online payment (i.e. Credit Card, Apple Pay, Google Pay)
- Use this form once even if you are submitting two quilts. Complete ALL sections. You will have a chance to edit your entries before submission.
- You will receive an email confirmation containing all the information you entered after you submit the form.
- Entry Fee is **\$10 per JUDGED** quilt.
- Non-judged quilt submission is FREE
- Quilts previously exhibited in our show may not be entered in this show.
- All quilts MUST HAVE a 4" sleeve for hanging.
- Entries must be quilted (thread stitched or tied) through all 3 layers (top, batting and backing), except specialty items in category 9.
- All quilts MUST HAVE a permanent ID label with the owner's name securely attached to the back of the quilt. For Judging, cover the label with fabric.
- All entrants must obtain necessary copyright releases for work that is covered under the copyright laws of the United States. Releases may be needed if the entrant used someone else's pattern, artwork, photography, or another quilt as your inspiration.
  - Note that releases may be needed even if the design has been altered.

## 2024 Awards for Judged Quilts

- First, second and third place in each category (at judge's discretion)
- Honorable Mentions at judge's discretion
- Best in Show at judge's discretion (selected from First Place winners in any/all categories)
- Excellence in Hand Workmanship awarded to person who entered the quilt; includes hand applique, hand piecing and hand quilting.
- Excellence in Machine Quilting awarded to person who entered the quilt.
- Judge's Choice
- Viewers' Choice (three ribbons)
