### Driving

#### Rock Springs Cafe

- ❖ Get out of the metro area and into the mountains. Head north on I 17, about an hour north of downtown phoenix. It's beautiful drive and the pie is worth it. This historical hotel is now a busy restaurant and pie shop.

#### South Mountain

- ❖ At more than 16,000 acres, South Mountain Park/Preserve is one of the largest municipally managed parks in the nation and consists of three mountain ranges - the Ma Ha Tauk, Gila, and Guadalupe. The park boasts more than 50 miles of trails for hiking, horseback riding and mountain biking. Additionally, the roadways throughout the park are a favorite for bicyclists.
- ❖ Dobbins Lookout, at 2,330 feet, is the highest point in the park that is available to the public. Accessed by both hiking trails and Summit Rd., the lookout is popular with tourists and locals, who want to get an unobstructed panoramic view of the Valley.
- ❖ Silent Sunday is the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of each month. This event closes the park's main roadway, Summit Road, to motor vehicle traffic during these times and the park's roadways are reserved for non-motorized activities such as walking, cycling, jogging, hiking, etc.

#### Roosevelt Reservoir & Globe

- ❖ Theodore Roosevelt Dam is a dam on the Salt River located northeast of Phoenix, Arizona. The dam is 357 feet (109 m) high and forms Theodore Roosevelt Lake as it impounds the Salt River. Originally built between 1905 and 1911, the dam was renovated and expanded in 1989–1996. The dam is named after President Theodore Roosevelt. Serving mainly for irrigation, water supply, and flood control, the dam also has a hydroelectric generating capacity of 36 megawatts.
- ❖ Globe is centrally located in Southern Arizona close to Roosevelt Reservoir. Visiting Globe is a perfect get away for a day trip or a weekend. Globe is located along the Historic Old West Highway, which takes you from Apache Junction, Arizona to Lordsburg, New Mexico. Come visit the Salado Indian Ruins at Besh-Ba-Gowah Archeological Park. Walk historic down-town and enjoy the Arizona sunshine while visiting our antique shops, or visit The Cobre Valley Center for the Arts and view the works of local artists. If you are looking for beautiful scenery take a short drive to the Pinal Mountains or Roosevelt Lake to see the desert landscape. Globe is within a two-hour drive to Phoenix or Tucson.

## Hikes

1. **Please don't go hiking after a night out and drinking. It endangers you and those around you.**
2. **Plan your hike! Research temperatures, popular times and use apps such as ALL TRAILS**
3. **Bring lots of water**

★ **Camelback:** Two trails (Echo and Chola Trails) of which only the Echo trail is open at this time. The Echo trail is difficult to very difficult. 2.5-mile out-and-back trail near Scottsdale, Arizona. Generally considered a challenging route, it takes an average of 1 h 47 min to 2.5 hours to complete. Elevation gain is 1,240 feet.

The Chola trail is less incline however is a longer trail. These trails are NOT child or pet friendly. May through September please consider not hiking this trail and if you do, start immediately when the trail opens at dawn.

★ **Pinnacle Peak:** 4.0-mile out-and-back trail near Scottsdale. Elevation gain is 1,030 feet. Generally considered a moderately challenging route, it takes an average of 2 -2.5 hours to complete. This is a very popular area for birding, hiking, and rock climbing, so you'll likely encounter other people while exploring. The trail is open year-round and is beautiful to visit anytime.

★ **Papago Park / Hole in the rock:** There are 8 great hiking trails, biking trails, running trails and more. Explore one of 7 easy hiking trails in Papago Park that are great for the whole family. Looking for a more strenuous hike? Trails ranging from 32 to 262 feet in elevation gain.

Hole in the rock is a 0.3-mile out-and-back trail near Phoenix, Arizona. Generally considered an easy route, it takes an average of 7 min to complete. This is a very popular area for hiking and walking, so you'll likely encounter other people while exploring. The trail is open year-round and is beautiful to visit anytime.

★ **Quartz Ridge and Trail 200 A Loop:** Experience this 2.9-mile loop trail near Paradise Valley, Arizona. Generally considered a moderately challenging route, it takes an average of 1 h 30 min to complete. Elevation gain is about 780 feet.

★ **Gateway Loop Trail:** Head out on this 4.4-mile loop trail near Scottsdale, Arizona. Generally considered a moderately challenging route, it takes an average of 1 h 58 min to complete. Elevation gain is 721 feet.
