**Things we will need to prepare for your dog,  
while at our [Board & Train Program](#).**

1. Please submit a copy of your dog's vaccination history right away.  
You or your vet can email to: [evk9services@gmail.com](mailto:evk9services@gmail.com)  
\*Check with your veterinarian that a Bordella Vaccine has been given within the last 6 months. If not, we would appreciate it if you would allow a minimum of 14 days after receiving this vaccine before bringing your dog to us.
2. Please ask each member of your family to answer A and B below.
  - A. **Make a list of words your dog seems to know and respond to.**  
This can be anything, nick names, what you say when you want the dog to go outside for elimination purposes, people names, toy names. Each person should write down any word the dog seems to be aware of. Include sounds if you use any, for example: whistling, finger snapping.....

**B. Make a list of annoyances from minor to major, that the dog does.**

This would be anything the dog does to annoy you. There is no wrong answer and don't presume anything is just a particular "breed trait" or a part of puppyhood to outgrow.

These list help us find many of the core issues faster and often point out direction's you could be headed towards, yet do not realize. These lists may be sent ahead or brought with you to the training center.

**3. Items to bring with you.**

- A 14 day supply of the dog food you are currently feeding your dog.
- Any medications that will need to be given while your dog is here with us: i.e., heartworm and or flea prevention.
- Food & Water bowls, bedding, a favorite toy.
