





The Need

- Global Hunger Rates are increasing.
 - Global Hunger increased from 8.3% in 2016, to an estimated 10% in 2022.
 - Every 10 seconds a child dies from malnutrition.
 - Globally in 2022, 49 countries are teetering on the edge of famine.
- Annual Natural Disasters and their severity are increasing.
 - On average 60,000 people die per a year from natural disasters.
 - Global natural disasters are estimated to increase to an average of 400 a year to 560 by 2030.
 - By 2030, the number of heat waves will triple, and droughts will increase by 30%.


Enrollment in Feeding Program









• Save the Children \$949.9M




Comparing

- Convoy of Hope, 38,000+ volunteers




