Please note that this is close to the scheduled time table but time schedules may fluctuate on route depending on circumstances involving travel time, rest stops and group photography stops. There is also a scheduled Fuel stop on route in Bunbury which I recommend All vehicles refuelling for the journey ahead.



## DETAILED PROGRAM

#### Day 1: Barbagallo to Manjimup Route

#### E-Route Link: https://ridewithgps.com/routes/28501118

Elevation vs Distance of Trip from Perth to Manjimup Maserati drivers with I.C.E. function in their vehicles will find the economical use of this feature during the cruising aspect of the journey to around the 230 km mark. Still others who have dedicated M or Manual mode with Paddle shifters will find in this mode that the Maserati vehicle will hold their dedicated gears and have a lot of fun with the difference in the exhaust note sounds!

From the 240 km mark onwards to the end of the journey– we start to progressively climb and also experience the twisty roads to Manjimup via Bridgetown and Balingup along the South West Highway. Sports mode in normal D or Drive or Drive with Paddle Shifters in S mode is recommended for that good old Maserati field.


For those experienced with their Maserati vehicle use S or Sports mode with M or Manual engaged and reveal in the use of the gearing for your cornering and braking. Note that throughout the entire Gran Fondo – we will NOT exceed the prescribed speed limits as we are compliant to the WA Road Rules as part of this event.

Route from Perth via West Coast Hwy through to Kwinana Freeway-Forrest Hwy to Bunbury and from there via South West Hwy to Manjimup. We will use the Freeway South to help clear most of the congestion of the Freeway all the way to Mandurah and beyond, turn into South West Highway from Bunbury (191 km from the start point) and head towards the timber country of Balingup (256 km from the start point) towards Bridgetown (282.5 km from the start) before we arrive in Manjimup (320.5 km from the start).



## DAY 2

#### Day 2: Journey from Truffle Wine Co to One Tree Bridge Manjimup

Part of the Gran Fondo is also appreciating the beauty and nature of the Southern Forests. The region is rich in history and in produce and we have enclosed for you some reading material about the produce of the region which makes all so important for preservation and the future of eco-tourism and agricultural tourism.

This quick photo stop is 20 km from the Truffle Wine Company and we are estimated to be there by 11:30 am for a 15 mins stopover thus leaving at 11:45 am.

#### Day 2: Journey from One Tree Bridge to Busselton

From One Tree Bridge we make our way through the forest country making our way through Graphite Road onwards to Nannup.

One Tree Bridge to Nannup is approximately 36 km of winding roads that will once again test your skills and the abilities of the Maserati vehicles in your capable hands. We should expect to pass Nannup therefore between 12 noon to 12:15 pm.


From there we head straight towards Busselton Jetty where the cafes by the Indian Ocean should whet your appetite for a light lunch before we head back to Perth.

The distance between Nannup and Busselton Jetty is around 64 km and as it is not always straight roads, so we should expect to arrive there by 1:00 pm.

Stopover in Busselton is 45 mins for that light lunch and we should be back on the road again by 1:45 pm for quick refuelling in the local petrol station before we head back to Barbagallo Maserati in Osborne Park.

Estimated departure time for Perth from Busselton 2:00pm. Distance from Busselton to Perth is 228 km which conservatively means we will arrive back at 4:45 pm.
