### YOUR Lake District

The Dunkirk Dam Lake District was formed in 1994 to maintain, protect, and improve the two-mile stretch of the Yahara River designated as the DDLD. The membership consists of owners of the riverfront properties on the Yahara River south of the City of Stoughton, but within the Town of Dunkirk, extending to and including the Dunkirk Dam. Members meet quarterly on the third Wednesday in January, April, July, and October. The DDLD is a true example of participatory democracy. Members who live in the district are eligible voters. Residents are represented by a five-member board of commissioners. The commissioners include an appointee from the Township of Dunkirk as well as Dane County providing the members with up-to-date information and beneficial cooperation as we strive to maintain the beauty and health of the Yahara River.
