## **Brittney Zamora Racing Proposal**

First, we would like to thank you for giving Brittney Zamora Racing the opportunity to present you with this partnership proposal outlining our plan for the 2021 racing season.

Square 1 Flex (SQ1) has signed to be a primary partner for Brittney Zamora Racing (BZR) for 2021 and beyond. SQ1 has agreed to allow other BZR partners the opportunity to take over primary partnership branding at select races if requested. As part of this agreement BZR partners will be provided advertising placement in the SQ1 app and data information from the app will be made available upon request. SQ1 is partners with FIS and Visa.

Brittney Zamora has agreed to partner with the USO for 2021 and beyond. The USO will provide opportunities for meet and great functions at select military bases prior to select races and BZR will host military personnel at select tracks COVID restrictions permitting.

Our current partners make the marketability of Brittney outside the racecar as beneficial as any ontrack action. Merchandising opportunities (tee shirts, hats, etc..) could be an avenue to jointly provide donations to local charities. We provide a grassroots marketing team willing to exceed the highest of expectations. Our proposal could include, but not be limited to the following.

- Brittney Zamora worn driver's suit, gloves, shoes available to be auctioned off for charity
- Personal appearances at events, trade shows etc... (race schedule permitting)
- VIP/Customer experiences at track (COVID restrictions permitting)
- VIP/Customer Pit Road Pals shelter visit experience (COVID restrictions permitting)
- VIP/Customer special events Example: Karting for (a cause) at a local Go-Kart facility

Our goal is to provide experiences that will create more of an off-track buzz for our partners than on-track.

A BZR partnership also allows a crossover to the boating community for our partners to participate in boating/PWC Poker Runs and beach festivals associated with organizations like Race World Offshore and American Powerboat Boat Association (APBA) if desired.

Brittney will start her NASCAR Xfinity Series career on April 9, 2021 at Martinsville Speedway. Brittney will become the first "regular" series female driver in the NASCAR Xfinity Series since Danica Patrick in 2015. Our current schedule provides a 16 race schedule with the option to add 13 more races.

The scheme for this proposal is the car raced in the NASCAR ARCA Series at Daytona International Speedway on February 13. The Xfinity Scheme for 2021 will be similar in color with additional branding locations available that are not available on the ARCA series car.



- For Brittney's NASCAR Xfinity Series debut on April 9 at Martinsville Speedway NASCAR and Phoenix Raceway have committed to using all their social media platforms to announce Brittney's debut in the Xfinity Series.
- Our schedule provides opportunities for Brittney to return to her roots racing Super Late Model (SLM) and Pro Late Model (PLM) races at Nashville Fairgrounds Speedway and Five Flags Speedway in Pensacola, FL.
- The May 8 race will be a double header where Brittney will race two races (two different series)
  in one day. The NASCAR ARCA East race will be the primary race and the support race will be
  the SLM North/South Showdown.

Current short track superstars like Bubba Pollard, Stephen Nasse and Derek Thorn make the All American 400 an all-star race that carries the weight of being one of the three best short track races of the year.
