Snow Removal Reminder (Yes, snow is here again!)

- ◆ The Right-of-Way is a dedicated strip of land intended for the accommodation of traffic movements, utilities, drainage, and other similar public uses. During the winter season, the right-of-way behind the roadway is reserved for snow storage to expedite snow removal. This area may extend seven feet or more beyond the road edge, into the Lot.



- ◆ Each owner of an adjacent walkway is required to remove the snow from the walkway. Your neighbors and their kids use the walkways for exercise and to get to school, a cleared walkway is safer than walking in the road. **Remind you plowing contractor to not plow snow into the walk way if you use one.**
- ◆ All snow from your driveway MUST be deposited on the lot from where it came. It is unlawful to deposit snow on to a public right of way or a neighbors lot. Please help out.
