

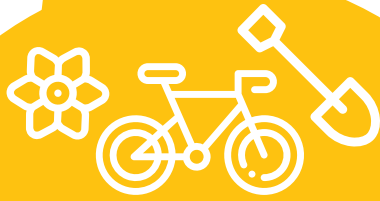


It is a fundamental right of every child.*
