
## Art Activity: Soaring Together

Have you ever gazed up at the sky and noticed a flock of birds flying together? Each bird is unique, yet when they are together in flight, they appear as a graceful, unified cloud of movement.

- 1. Close your eyes and imagine what this might look like.
- 2. Using the bird template, create a design that reflects who you are. What brings you joy? Is there a person, animal, place or activity that sparks joy? Draw, colour or collage your ideas.
- 3. Cut out your bird and hang it beside your friends' creations. Notice how each bird is unique and together they form a beautiful flock.
