

WOODLAWN CEMETERY

REGULATIONS FOR LOT DECORATIONS

The Association/Cemetery Board reserves the right to regulate the method of decorating the plots/monuments so that a uniform beauty may be maintained. We are reminded by lot owners-and rightfully so-that lots were sold with a clear outline as to floral and plant decoration regulations and that disregard of these rules destroys the originally intended effect.

The Association is not responsible or liable for theft, vandalism, or other causes beyond its control.

Floral Containers allowed:

Concrete urns, clay pots, pedestal baskets or metal pinpoint containers are allowable. No glass, plastic, or wood containers are permitted.

One container per lot of 1, 2 or 3 graves is acceptable or, 2 containers on 4 or more graves. Containers must be placed at the side of the monument, on a concrete foundation plate, installed by cemetery personnel. Single grave lots may have a pot on top of the flush marker, a pedestal basket at the side or a metal pinpoint container at the side of the marker. No concrete flower plates are allowed beside flush markers.

Fresh cut flowers and potted plants are permitted at all times. Withered plants and flowers are removed regularly. Floral bouquets may be placed in a metal pinpoint container and placed at the side of the monument, or, a bouquet may be placed on the grave (on the grass) and will be disposed of in approximately a week.

- **All flowers will be removed starting October 1st.**
- **No artificial flowers or artificial decorations made of plastic, silk, etc. are allowed from April 1st to October 1st.**
- **Artificial flowers and Evergreen Wreaths are acceptable from November 1st to April 1st.**
- **American Flags on Veterans graves are allowed year-round, placed in an urn or pot.**
- **These rules and regulations apply to Babyland, also.**

No planting on graves of any kind is allowed. All memorials, monuments, flower containers or decorations are subject to the approval of the Association/Cemetery Board.

Ornaments Prohibited: The placing of boxes, shells, toys, figurines, metal designs, candles, lanterns, ornaments, chairs, settees, vases, glass, plastic, wood, iron cases, statues, shepard hooks, hanging baskets, trees, food items, chains, hooks, rope and similar articles, upon lots or monuments, shall not be permitted, except when authorized by the Association/Cemetery Board, and if so placed, the Association/Cemetery Board reserves the right to remove the same. If an article is not mentioned above, it is not allowed and will be removed, No exceptions.
