

WOODLAWN CEMETERY ASSOCIATION
REGULATIONS FOR LOT DÉCOR

(Effective February 9, 2021)

Grave décor and flowers are permitted when supplied by the family and when they comply with the cemetery rules and regulations. No signs, notices or advertisements of any kind are allowed on the cemetery grounds and soliciting within the cemetery is prohibited. Woodlawn Cemetery Association and the Board of Trustees reserves the right to regulate the manner in which graves, niches and memorials are decorated to maintain uniformity and beauty throughout cemetery grounds. Any décor not meeting and/or following the requirements will be removed. Woodlawn Cemetery Association is not responsible or liable for theft, vandalism or other causes beyond its control.

- No artificial flowers or décor is permitted during the ‘growing season”; live flowers/plants only
- Fall Clean Off Date is **October 15th** – all flowers, plants and décor will be removed
- Spring Clean Off Date is **April 15th** – all artificial flowers, décor and wreaths will be removed
- American flags are permitted year-round on veteran’s graves
- Flower pots, pedestal baskets and pinpoint containers are permitted
- All arrangements must be placed on either side of the memorial(headstone)
