

- Nothing may be placed on the grass; flower pots require the placement of a concrete foundation installed by cemetery personnel
- One container is permitted for a single grave; 2 containers are permitted for 2 or more graves
- Planting of any kind is not permitted on graves. Plantings will be done only by cemetery personnel in approved areas
- Solar lights are permitted only when placed within flower pots and pedestal baskets
- The following are not to be placed on graves at any time: shepherds hooks, hanging baskets, glass vases, statues, candles, lanterns, toys, etc.
- No stickers, emblems or ornaments are to be adhered to niche fronts unless approved by the cemetery

** As of April 15th, 2021, concrete urns/pots will no longer be permitted anywhere in the cemetery. This includes the placement at/around the columbarium. Many are not being utilized and are in disrepair. For this reason, Woodlawn Cemetery Association has chosen to eliminate them completely.
