Officers represent Triton's commitment to professionalism, operational readiness, and lawful enforcement within the scope of Florida Statute 493.

This is a **1099 Independent Contractor position**, not W-2 employment.

1099 INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT

This role is structured as a 1099 Independent Contractor agreement. Officers are responsible for:

- Federal and state taxes
- Maintaining required licenses (Class D / Class G if armed)
- Maintaining required equipment
- Personal insurance coverage
- Compliance with all training requirements

Nothing in this position constitutes an employer-employee relationship.

SCOPE OF RESPONSIBILITIES

Security Officers may be assigned to:

- Residential communities
- Commercial properties
- Construction sites
- Churches
- Event venues
- Executive Protection assignments
- Mobile patrol operations
- Firewatch Patrol operations



Duties may include:

- Conducting access control
- Performing foot and vehicle patrols
- Responding to disturbances
- Issuing trespass warnings
- Documenting incidents
- Coordinating with law enforcement when required
- Providing visible deterrence
- Enforcing client property rules within lawful authority

Officers must operate within Florida Statutes 493, 776, and 784.

CONNECTTEAM REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

All officers are required to:

- Clock in and out using the Connecteam App
- Submit Daily Activity Reports
- Submit Incident Reports before end of shift
- Document patrol checkpoints when required
- Acknowledge policy updates within the app
- Maintain training compliance through Connecteam modules

Failure to properly document assignments may result in removal from the active roster.

WORK SCHEDULE & ASSIGNMENT EXPECTATIONS

Officers:

- May be assigned to multiple client sites
- Must be flexible based on operational needs
- May work extended assignments of **12 hours or more**
- May work multiple assignments within a 24-hour period when operationally necessary

Assignments are offered based on company needs. Refusal of more than three (3) assignments within a 90-day period may result in termination of contractor agreement.

Failure to report to more than three (3) scheduled assignments may result in termination.

EMERGENCY & SEVERE WEATHER EXPECTATION

Security Officers are considered critical personnel.

During:

- Emergency Orders
- Hurricanes
- Severe weather conditions
- Civil unrest events

Officers may be required to remain on post until properly relieved.

Abandonment of post during emergency conditions constitutes immediate termination.



TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

All officers must maintain active compliance with Triton training standards.

Annual Requirements:

- 4-Hour Defensive Tactics Training (\$75 annual training fee)
- Firearms Qualification (Armed Officers)
- Use of Force Legal Update
- De-escalation / CIT Training
- Active Shooter Response Training
- Report Writing & Articulation Training

Connecteam Course Requirements:

- Triton Orientation
- Use of Force Certification
- Communications SOP & 10-Code Protocol
- Mental Health Response Module
- Patrol / EP Operations (if assigned)
- Annual Policy Acknowledgment

Failure to maintain training compliance results in inactive status.

EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS

Contractors must provide and maintain:

- Duty belt & holster
- Firearm (if armed position)
- Body armor/carrier vest
- Handcuffs
- Baton
- OC spray
- Flashlight (500+ lumens)
- Body-worn Camera
- Reliable smartphone for Connecteam reporting

Some uniform items may be issued at company discretion.

PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS

Officers must:

- Maintain professional grooming and appearance
 - Wear approved uniform
 - Conduct themselves in a law enforcement-level professional manner
 - Avoid escalation based on ego
 - Demonstrate emotional regulation under stress
 - Document incidents accurately and objectively

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- 21 years of age (armed positions)
 - Valid Florida Class D license (required)
 - Valid Class G license (armed positions)
 - Valid driver's license
 - Reliable transportation
 - Ability to stand/walk for extended periods
 - Ability to articulate incidents in written form
 - No disqualifying criminal history
