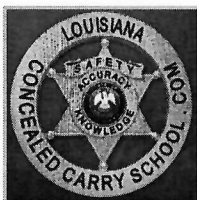


# LOUISIANA CONCEALED CARRY SCHOOL

- \_\_\_ 1. **LACK OF KNOWLEDGE** OF THE RULES FOR SAFE GUN HANDLING AND/OR OF THE PROPER SAFE WAY TO OPERATE A PISTOL IS ONE OF THE CAUSES OF FIREARM ACCIDENTS.

- \_\_\_\_\_ 16. IF YOU ARE GOING TO SOMEONE ELSE'S HOME FOR DINNER, YOU ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE THE CONSENT OF THAT PERSON TO CARRY YOUR HANDGUN INTO THEIR HOME.

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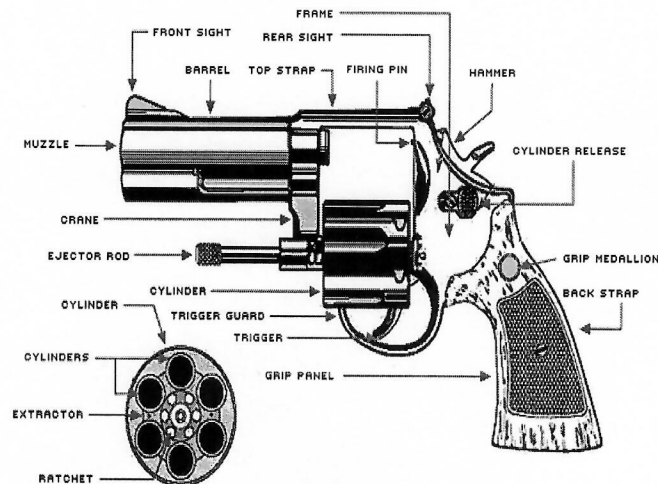
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- \_\_\_\_\_ 37. THE SHOOTING POSITION IS THE PLATFORM FROM WHICH ALL OF THE SHOOTING FUNDAMENTALS ARE EXECUTED. A POSITION SHOULD BE COMFORTABLE, BALANCED, RELAXED AND PROPERLY ALIGNED WITH THE TARGET.

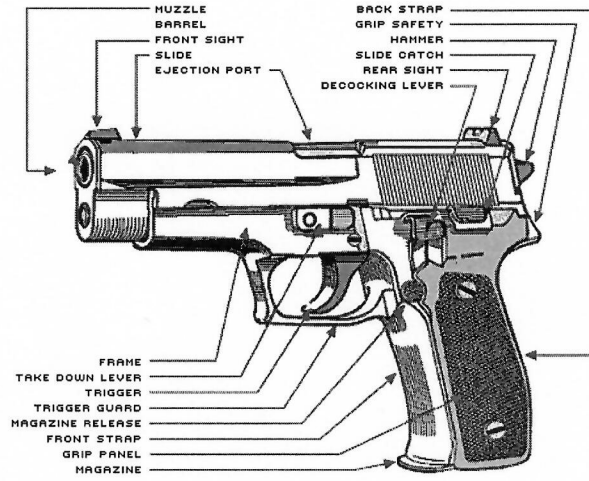

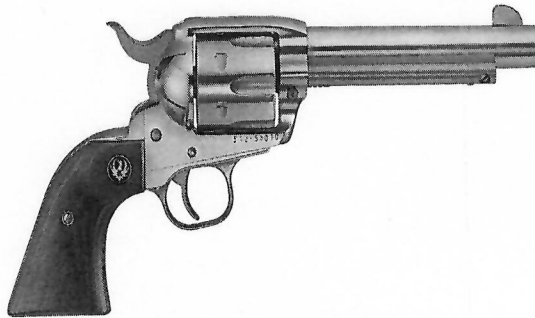

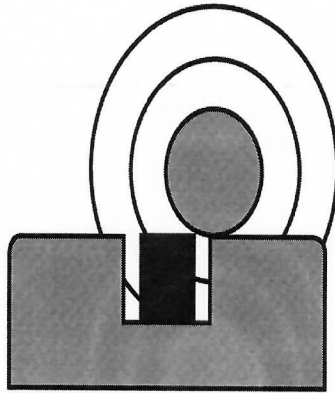

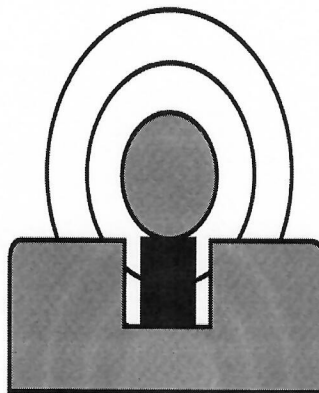

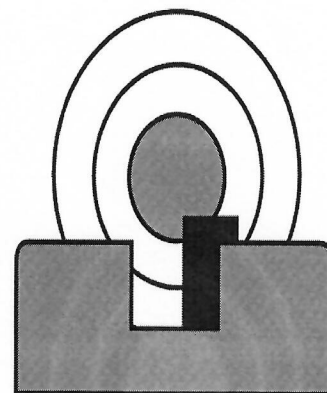
